

Court of Common Pleas Notice to the Bar

At the direction of Honorable James J. Fitzgerald, Administrative Judge, Trial Division, Court of Common Pleas, and Honorable D. Webster Keogh, Supervising Judge, Trial Division, Court of Common Pleas effective January 2, 2007, please be advised of the following changes to courtroom assignments at the Criminal Justice Center:

1. Common Pleas Court Arraignments will be conducted in Courtroom 705 in the Criminal Justice Center at 8:00 a.m. instead of the current location in Courtroom 504 at 10:30 a.m.
2. Common Pleas Court and Municipal Court bench warrant hearings heard by trial commissioners at the Criminal Justice Center will be conducted in Courtroom 503 in the Criminal Justice Center at 1:00 p.m. instead of Courtroom 504 at 1:00 p.m.
3. Forfeiture hearings will be conducted in Courtroom 446 in City Hall at 9:00 a.m. instead of the current location in Courtroom 705 at 9:00 a.m.
4. Courtroom 705 in the Criminal Justice Center will become the Track Room for the Felony Waiver Program. The Track Room will commence proceedings at 10:30 a.m. or directly following Common Pleas Court Arraignments. The Honorable Joan A. Brown will be assigned to the Track Program.
5. The Honorable Glenn Bronson will continue his assignment in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 504.
6. The Honorable Chris R. Wogan will continue his assignment in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 604.
7. The Honorable Joseph A. Dych will continue his assignment in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 304.
8. Courtroom 1103, previously a Municipal Court courtroom, will temporarily be changed to a Common Pleas Court Felony Waiver courtroom until June 29th, 2007. The Honorable A. Frank Reynolds will preside in courtroom 1103 and continue his assignment in the Felony Waiver Program.
9. The Honorable Leslie Fleisher will be re-assigned from the Track Program to the Felony Waiver Program and will preside in Courtroom 904.
10. The Honorable Leon Tucker will be re-assigned from the Gun Court Program to the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 1008.
11. The Honorable George W. Overton will be re-assigned from the Section Calendar Program to Gun Court and will preside in Courtroom 505.
