BAIL MOTIONS

Effective January 4th, 2010 all Common Pleas Court Bail Motions filed before the Formal Arraignment date will be scheduled to Motions Court, Courtroom 504 CJC, within ten (10) business days. If a Bail Motion is filed after Formal Arraignment but before the Discovery Court date then the Motion will be contemporaneously with the Discovery Court date. If the Bail Motion is filed after Formal Arraignment but before a Trial Readiness Room date it will be assigned that same date UNLESS the Trial Readiness date is further than ten (10) business days from the date the Bail Motion is filed. In those instances the Bail Motion will be given a hearing date in the Trial Readiness Room within ten (10) business days.

NOTICE TO THE BAR

MOTIONS TO QUASH

Effective January 4th, 2010, when a Motion to Quash is filed for a Common Pleas Court case the Motions clerk will schedule a hearing date contemporaneous with the next action date assigned to the underlying case. For example, when the Motion is filed before the Formal Arraignment date the Quash will get that same date and room location. Likewise, if the case for which a Motion to Quash is being filed is listed for Discovery Court or a Trial Readiness Hearing, the Motion to Quash hearing will be scheduled contemporaneous with whichever date is scheduled for the underlying matter.
