Changes in Judicial Assignment In the Criminal Trial Division
Effective July 1, 2002

The Honorable Thomas Dempsey is reassigned from the Section Calendar Program to the Track Program and will preside in Courtroom 503.

The Honorable Albert John Snite, Jr. is reassigned from the Civil Trial Division to the Criminal Trial Division and will preside in Section B of the Section Calendar Program. Judge Snite will assume the major felony inventory previously assigned to the Honorable Thomas Dempsey in Courtroom 808. Homicide cases previously assigned to Judge Dempsey's inventory will be reassigned to the Honorable William J. Mazzola.

The Honorable Willis W. Berry, Jr. will retain his present inventory and remain in Section C but is reassigned to Courtroom 502.

The Honorable Renee Cardwell Hughes is reassigned to Section A in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 608. Judge Hughes' inventory will consist of private counsel major felony cases laterally reassigned from other inventories within the Section Calendar Program.

The Honorable Sheila Woods-Skipper is reassigned from the Track Program to Section B in the Section Calendar Program. Judge Woods-Skipper will assume the major felony inventory previously assigned to the Honorable William J. Mazzola. Judge Woods-Skipper will preside in Courtroom 1107.

The Honorable Denis P. Cohen will retain his present Drug Forfeiture inventory but will be reassigned to Courtroom 601.

The Honorable William J. Mazzola remains assigned to Section D in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 1102. Judge Mazzola's homicide inventory will consist of homicide cases previously assigned to his inventory and homicide cases reassigned from other mixed calendar inventories.

Courtroom 905 will continue to consist of private counsel felony List Room Program cases.
