INFORMATION FOR MEDIA

Approximately thirty (30) seats in Courtroom 305 of the Criminal Justice Center are designated for members of the news media. Seats will be set aside for sketch artists.

Those wishing to attend the proceedings in this matter are advised to arrive early. All spectators must be seated fifteen (15) minutes before court is called to order.

Security is very strict. All media representatives in and around the courtroom must possess an official news agency identification **and** be issued a pass by the Court. Foreign media representatives may be required to offer some other authentic media credential for admittance. Passes will be available at the entrance to the courtroom. Identification and pass must both be presented each day for admittance to court and the press section.

PASSES MUST BE SURRENDERED WHEN YOU LEAVE FOR THE DAY.

All persons and belongings are subject to being searched both at the entry to the courthouse and the entry to the courtroom. The following items are not permitted in the courthouse:

- * Firearms, knives, letter openers, screwdrivers, scissors, mace, pepper spray and other potential weapons.
- * Cellular telephones, pagers, Palm Pilots, cameras, tape recorders, lap top computers and other electronic devices.

Because seating in the courtroom is tight, large pocket books, briefcases and backpacks should not be brought into the courtroom (excepting materials required by accredited sketch artists).
