

JUDGE PAMELA PRYOR DEMBE

Judge Pamela Pryor Dembe has been a Common Pleas judge for 23 years and is the President Judge of the Common Pleas Court. She is a graduate of Temple University School of Law and has lived in Philadelphia for approximately 40 years.

Judge Dembe is the Past President of the of State Trial Judges' organization, the Pennsylvania Bar Association's Criminal Law Section, the Brehon Law Society; and the Friends of the Free Library of Philadelphia. Presently, she is Vice President of the Board of the Free Library of Philadelphia as well as Past President of the Temple Inn of Court and a director of the Clover Club. She is also Chair of the Pennsylvania Judicial Auditing Agency.

She is a member of the Union League of Philadelphia, serving on numerous committees, a trustee of Corinthian Yacht Club, and member of the Athenaeum, and the Orpheus Club.
