Attorney Activity Available on the Internet

The Trial Division of the First Judicial District of Pennsylvania is pleased and proud to announce that a “case activity-by attorney” report is now available through the court's web site, courts.phila.gov. An attorney can access all Civil and Orphans' Court cases and corresponding court schedules for all active cases in which that attorney has entered an appearance. There are options for both summary and detailed information with hotlinks to the full docket for any case.

As an added feature, the application can also be downloaded onto a hand-held computer for wireless access.

This convenience can be accessed by counsel through the entry of counsel's “Attorney I.D. number”. Any attorney who wishes to maintain the confidentiality of his/her activity may do so by supplying the court with a “password”, which when obtained by counsel and entered along with the “Attorney I.D. number” will prevent anyone other than that attorney from accessing the pertinent case activity report for that attorney. This “password” must be limited to twelve (12) characters.

To obtain a password, counsel should write to the Prothonotary (attention: Joseph Evers) on letterhead stationery.

The court is pleased to advise that presently there will be no charge for this report.
