Changes In Judicial Assignments In The Criminal Trial Division Effective June 30, 2003

The Honorable Lillian H. Ransom is reassigned from the List Program to Section D in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 608. Judge Ransom's inventory will consist of major felony cases previously assigned to the Honorable M. Teresa Sarmina in Courtroom 507.

Felony waiver cases previously assigned to the Honorable Lillian H. Ransom in Courtroom 1104 which were listed for trial on June 30, 2003 and beyond have been administratively reassigned to the inventories of the felony waiver courtrooms in the List Program.

The Honorable Joan A. Brown is reassigned to Courtroom 1104 and will remain in Section A. Judge Brown will retain her present inventory.

The Honorable M. Teresa Sarmina will retain her present homicide inventory and will preside in Courtroom 507 but is reassigned from Section D to Section C. Judge Sarmina's inventory will consist of only homicide cases.

The Honorable Annette M. Rizzo will be reassigned from Section C to Section D Leader and will continue to preside in Courtroom 901. Judge Rizzo will retain her present major felony inventory.

The Honorable Sheila Woods-Skipper will remain as Section C Leader and preside in Courtroom 1107. Judge Woods-Skipper will retain her present major felony inventory and will also be assigned homicide cases from the Homicide Pretrial Calendar Room. Judge Woods-Skipper will retain a mixed calendar inventory.
