Changes in Judicial Assignments and Programs
In the Criminal Division
Effective March 7, 2005

The Honorable Frank Reynolds, formerly of the Family Court Division, is now sitting as a Senior Judge in the Criminal Division, and will be assigned to the List Program. Judge Reynolds will assume the felony waiver inventory previously assigned to the Honorable Joseph A. Dych in Courtroom 505.

The Honorable Joseph A. Dych is reassigned from the List Program in the Criminal Division to the Civil Division.

The Honorable Glenn B. Bronson is assigned to the Criminal Division and will assume the felony waiver inventory previously assigned to Honorable Thomas Dempsey in Courtroom 605.

The Honorable Thomas Dempsey is reassigned from the List Program to Section E in the Section Calendar Program and will preside in Courtroom 901. Judge Dempsey will resume his major felony inventory previously managed by the Honorable Gary S. Glazer in Courtroom 1102.

The Honorable Gary S. Glazer is reassigned from the Section Calendar Program in the Criminal Division to the Civil Division.

The Honorable Susan I. Schulman is assigned to the Criminal Division and will assume the felony waiver inventory previously assigned to the Honorable Glynnis Hill in Courtroom 704.

The Honorable Glynnis Hill is reassigned from the List Program to Section A in the Section Calendar Program. Judge Hill will assume the major felony inventory previously assigned to the Honorable George W. Overton in Courtroom 1004.

The Honorable Earl W. Trent, Jr. is reassigned from the Family Court Division to the Criminal Division and will be assigned to the List Program. Judge Trent will assume the felony waiver inventory previously assigned to the Honorable Denis P. Cohen in Courtroom 1005.

The Honorable Denis P. Cohen is reassigned from the List Program to Section C in the Section Calendar Program. Judge Cohen will preside in Courtroom 1105 and will assume the major felony inventory previously assigned to Judge Maier in Courtroom 1007.

The Honorable Harold M. Kane will retain his present mixed calendar inventory and remain as Section B Leader but will preside in Courtroom 1102.
