If you have an outstanding bench warrant, this is your opportunity to resolve your past due child support and bench warrant **WITHOUT** fear of being arrested.

*You can avoid arrest*

If you fail to take advantage of this opportunity the following actions may be taken:

- \*You may be arrested which could lead to fines and incarceration of up to 6 months
- \*Names of delinquent payors may be published in newspapers and other media venues
- \*Professional license suspension
- \*Drivers license suspension
- \*Passport denied
- \*State and Federal tax refunds intercepted
- \*Past due support reported to Credit Bureaus
- \*Past due support reduced to a judgment
