

**NOTICE TO THE BAR AND PUBLIC
RELOCATION OF PHILADELPHIA FAMILY COURT**

The Philadelphia Family Court will begin relocating its operations to the new Family Court Building on Friday, November 7, 2014 at close of business. Full operations will resume at the new Family Court Building, which is located at 1501 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA, at 8:00 AM on Monday, November 17, 2014.

A. Limited services will be provided by the Juvenile Branch during the move as follows:

*For this purpose, "Time sensitive" filings are those that seek emergency relief (other than PFA or custody) and/or filings that must be filed on or before a date certain or within a specified number of business or calendar days, pursuant to an applicable statute, Rule of Procedure, Administrative Regulation, or order of court. Examples of time sensitive filings include appeals, petitions/motions for reconsideration, exceptions, legal briefs or memoranda of law with assigned filing deadlines.

The Juvenile Branch will resume all operations during normal weekday business hours from 8:00AM until 4:00 PM at the new location of the Philadelphia Family Court at 1501 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA 19102.
